

## Frequently Asked Questions: Water Valley Hall Rental

How many people does the hall hold? 155 people

During what hours can renters have music (make noise) outside? Music/noise may occur from 7 am to 11 pm. You can dance anytime, but after 11 pm you will need to put on earphones.

Do renters need a liquor permit? Yep. And you need to have it on display during your event. Contact your liquor provider or Alberta government about this. It's not onerous or expensive if you plan ahead. Renters are responsible for getting the permit and complying with government regulations regarding alcohol. We are not trying to put more rules on you - see your MP to complain.

What about insurance? PAL Insurance must be purchased when you are serving alcohol. Contact your home insurance broker for this.

Can renters have a bonfire? Of course! Fires must be contained in the pits provided. BYOFW (Bring your own firewood - PLEASE do not rob our forest). There will be no other fires or portable pits brought onto property. Also, be aware of fire restrictions in the area. Fires must be out by 1am.

Can renters have fireworks? Of course, we know you want to have fun! PLEASE, confirm with WVCA before having fireworks. You need WRITTEN permission from WVCA.
